Dear Secretary Pritchard:

I represent SHHAIR (an acronym for Safeguarding the Historic Hanscom Area's Irreplaceable Resources, Inc.), which is a non-profit corporation dedicated to preservation of the environmental and historic resources in the area of Hanscom Field. SHHAIR is concerned about the creation of a new terminal and other activities at Hanscom Field without compliance with the state's environmental review laws.

Enclosed is a Notice of Project Change, requesting that the MEPA office require an environmental notification form and environmental review for the proposed Crosspoint lease and development, which proposes a new terminal at Massachusetts Port Authority's L.G. Hanscom Field ("Project"), and therefore triggers a MEPA threshold for an ENF and EIR.

In the alternative, we request that you treat the enclosed Notice as a request for an advisory opinion that the Project requires an ENF.
